

# Smart glasses comparison

Four shortlisted glasses for the Matsui project, with demo videos · Techno Brave Asia, XR team · June 2026

We checked nine industrial glasses. These four made the shortlist. **Moziware Cimo** was chosen. Rokid Glass 2 was compared fairly, and lost mainly on **price, camera, and age**.

Epson Moverio BT-45 was also checked. It has a nice binocular see-through display, but sellers flag it as end-of-life, so it was dropped. All prices are estimates until a reseller confirms.

## Why Moziware Cimo won, and why not Rokid

Remote assistance lives in the **camera and the microphones**, and the product runs on a **factory floor**. The Moziware Cimo is built for exactly that, at the lowest price. Rokid Glass 2 is a capable, proven glass (the video shows it on remote expert calls in a German factory), but for this project it does not win:

- It costs **about \$3,000, roughly double the Moziware Cimo**.
- It is a **2020 model** with a weaker **1080p camera**, while remote support depends on camera quality.
- Its light 96 g weight **excludes a tethered battery pack**, so it is less self-contained than it looks.
